HORSE RIDING AND PARTICIPATION IN HORSE RELATED ACTIVITY IS DANGEROUS

I understand and acknowledge that horse riding and participation in horse related activity is dangerous and that horses act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt. I understand and acknowledge that serious INJURY or DEATH may result from participating in horse related activity.

I agree that I and my children PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK.

"I hereby certify that every horse and rider is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the constitution and rules of Equine Canada and Horse Council BC at this event. It is hereby recognized that all equine sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless Equine Canada, HCBC, the Boundary Horse Association, their officials, organizers, agents and their representatives. I will not hold the Boundary Horse Association responsible for any injury, damage or loss that might occur during this event. I agree to follow all directions of the management/organizer of the event and understand that my failure or refusal to do so will result in my immediate disqualification from the activity and the forfeiting of all fees paid in relation to the activity."

BHA SHOW RULES

1. Entries must be received **postmarked by date as indicated** on the "Entry Form". **Cancellation refund only upon receipt of veterinary certificate.**
2. Classes may be divided or combined at the discretion of the judge and show committee.
3. The horse show committee reserves the right to make decisions on matters not included in these rules, barring conflict with CEF/EC rules, to correct or alter these rules, the prize list or program. **The show committee will follow the mandate of the Equine Canada Rule Book for General Performance.**
4. Approved helmets are mandatory for riders **UNDER 18** at all times. Appropriate tack and attire is mandatory for the class being ridden. Please refer to EC Rule books for the correct equipment guidelines. The Show Secretary will have a copy of the rules available for those wishing clarification.
5. There will be no re-runs for defective equipment, please check your tack prior to entering your class.
6. **The judge's decision is final in all classes.** Protests may be made in writing and presented to the Show Secretary within 48 hours of the incident and be accompanied by a \$100.00 fee.
7. No person (other than show officials) may enter the judging area and/or hold a conversation with the judge during show hours without prior approval of show management.
8. Competition number must be worn in plain sight at all times when exhibitor is on the grounds. The lack of visible number during the course of a class is grounds for disqualification from the class.
9. Horse owners shall be responsible for all damage or injury incurred by their horse, rider, family members or agents.
10. A contestant demonstrating unsafe/unsportsmanlike behavior including inappropriate language or profanity, or abusive treatment of an animal will not be tolerated. Any offender will be disqualified from the show without refund of entries.
11. Horses must be kept at a walk on the show grounds at all times, unless in show ring or warm-up area.
12. Stallions must be exhibited only by a "senior" handler, and may not be housed overnight at the BHA Grounds, unless approved.
13. Any horse exhibiting symptoms of a contagious disease will be asked to leave the grounds and cannot return without a veterinary certificate indicating fitness to show.
14. Do not congregate around the entry gate – this area needs to be kept clear for safety reasons. Please follow the directions of the gatekeeper or the whipper-in for your order of go.
15. A horse may be shared between riders; however each rider must have their individual competition number, with class entries paid by each rider.
16. Horses not entered in the show will not be allowed on the grounds unless prior arrangements have been made with the show management.
17. ALL DOGS MUST be kept on a leash at all times.
18. Horses known to kick MUST wear a red ribbon tied in their tail to warn other riders.
19. Green horse/rider may ride two handed but must be in a legal snaffle bit. Martingales are not permitted.
20. **Gate holds:** You may request a gate hold if you have back to back classes, in which you are changing horse, tack or rider. If no gate hold is requested you will only have 3 calls and then the gate will be closed and you will miss your class. **No refund for class.**
